4) ...his wage for work was not a debt _____ by God. v4

4 Now to the one who works, his wage is not credited as a favor, but as what is due. [Rom 4:4 NASB]

5) ...his faith was in God imputing _____ . 2Cor9:15

15 Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift! [2Co 9:15 NASB]
