1) ...in _____ with God 2Co 5:18-19

18 Now all [these] things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, 19 namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation. [2Co 5:18-19 NASB]

2) ...in _____ to God's grace Eph 1:3

3 Blessed [be] the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly [places] in Christ, [Eph 1:3 NASB]

3) ...in _____ glory Jhn 11:40

40 Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?" [Jhn 11:40]

2. ...in a hope that doesn't _____ US. Psa 25:3; 1Jo 2:28

3 Indeed, none of those who wait for You will be ashamed; Those who deal treacherously without cause will be ashamed. [Psa 25:3 NASB]

28 Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming. [1Jo 2:28 NASB]

1) ...even in _____ . 2Co 4:17

17 For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, [2Co 4:17 NASB]

2) ...when suffering _____ perseverance. Rom 8:25

25 But if we hope for what we do not see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it. [Rom 8:25 NASB]

3) ...when perseverance _____ your faith. Jas 1:12

12 Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been **approved**, he will receive the crown of life which [the Lord] has promised to those who love Him. [Jas 1:12 NASB]

4) ...when proven faith accomplishes _____ . Rom 8:24; 15:13

24 For in hope we have been saved, but hope that is seen is not hope;[G1680] **for who hopes for what he [already] sees?** [Rom 8:24 NASB]

13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you will abound in hope **by the power of the Holy Spirit.** [Rom 15:13 NASB]

3...because God's love has been _____ ... Mar 14:24; Eph 1:7-8

24 And He said to them, "This is My blood of the covenant, which is **poured out** for many. [Mar 14:24]

7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace 8 which **He lavished on us.** In all wisdom and insight [Eph 1:7-8 NASB]

1) ...in our _____ . 2Co 4:6

6 For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is **the One who has shone in our hearts** to give the Light of the knowledge of **the glory of God** in the face of Christ. [2Co 4:6 NASB]

2) ...through the _____ of His spirit. Gal 4:6

6 Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son **into our hearts**, crying, "Abba! Father!" [Gal 4:6 NASB]

5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and **renewing of the Holy Ghost**; 6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; [Tit 3:5-6]

13 By this we know that **we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.** [1Jo 4:13 NASB]

13 In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation--having also believed, you were sealed in Him with **the Holy Spirit** of promise, 14 who is given as **a pledge of our inheritance**, with a view to the redemption of [God's own] possession, to the praise of His glory. [Eph 1:13-14 NASB]

21 Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God, 22 who also sealed us and gave [us] **the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.** [2Co 1:21-22 NASB]

30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom **you were sealed for the day of redemption.** [Eph 4:30 NASB]
