## \_\_\_\_\_ Headship View Deu 24:16

"Fathers shall not be put to death for [their] sons, nor shall sons be put to death for [their] fathers; everyone shall be put to death for his own sin." - Deu 24:16 NASB

Natural [\_\_\_\_\_] Headship View. Exo 34:7 "[God] who keeps lovingkindness for thousands, who forgives iniquity, transgression and sin; yet He will by no means leave [the guilty] unpunished, visiting the iniquity of fathers on the children and on the grandchildren to the third and fourth generations."" - Exo 34:7 NASB

The gift is not like [that which came] through the one who sinned; for on the one hand the judgment [arose] from one [transgression] resulting in condemnation, but on the other hand the free gift [arose] from many transgressions resulting in justification. - Rom 5:16 NASB
