- Known for his partial translation of the Bible into the English language.

- · He opposed Henry the VIII's planned annulment of his marriage to Catherine of Argon
- He died at the stake on October 6, 1536 saying "Lord! Open the King of England's eyes."

#### John Knox

- a galley slave on a French ship John Knox prayed with firm resolve, "Lord, give me Scotland, ere I die."
- He told Mary Queen of Scots "If princes exceed their bounds, Madam, no doubt they may be resisted, even by power."
- One of the Scottish earls said of Knox at his funeral, "There lies one who in his life never feared the face of man."
