"Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?" - 1Co 6:19

"The eternal God is a dwelling place, And underneath are the everlasting arms..." Deu 33:27 NASB

"so that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." - Rom 5:21

"just as David also speaks of the blessing on the man to whom God credits righteousness apart from works: "BLESSED ARE THOSE WHOSE LAWLESS DEEDS HAVE BEEN FORGIVEN, AND WHOSE SINS HAVE BEEN COVERED. "BLESSED IS THE MAN WHOSE SIN THE LORD WILL NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT."" - Rom 4:6-8 NASB
