(1) The _____ Call Mt22:14; Jn7:37

- 1) **There is a call but _____ does not follow.** — “For many are called [κλητός - **klatos**], but few [are] _____.” - Mat 22:14 NASB95
- 2) **The general call does not _____ action against the will.** — “Now on the last day, the great [day] of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out [κράζω - **krazo**], saying, "If **anyone** is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink." - Jhn 7:37 NASB95
- 3) **The invitation goes out to _____.** — The "But Jesus said to him, "A man once gave a great banquet and **invited** [καλέω - **kaleo**] many guests. At the time for the banquet he sent his slave to tell those who had been invited, 'Come, because everything is now ready.' But one after another they all began to make excuses. The first said to him, 'I have bought a field, and I must go out and see it. Please excuse me.' Another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going out to examine them. Please excuse me.' Another said, 'I just got married, and I cannot come.' So the slave came back and reported this to his master. Then the master of the household was furious and said to his slave, 'Go out quickly to the streets and alleys of the city, and bring in the poor, the crippled, the blind, and the lame.' Then the slave said, 'Sir, what you instructed has been done, and there is still room.' So the master said to his slave, 'Go out to the highways and country roads and urge people to come in, so that my house will be filled. For I tell you, not one of those individuals who were invited will taste my banquet!'" - Luk 14:16-24 NET

- 2) **This call was granted from _____.** — “who has saved us and **called**[G2564] us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but **according to His own purpose and grace** which was **granted** us in Christ Jesus **from all eternity**," - 2Ti 1:9 NASB95
- 3) **This call is to eternal _____.** — “Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of **the eternal life to which you were called**,[G2564] and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses." - 1Ti 6:12 NASB95

- 4) **You have been called to** _____ . — "For God has not **called**[G2564] us for the purpose of impurity, but **in sanctification**." - 1Th 4:7
- 5) **You are chosen as God's own** _____ . — "But you are A **CHOSEN** RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR [God's] OWN **POSSESSION**, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has **called**[G2564] **you** out of darkness into His marvelous light;" - 1Pe 2:9 NASB95
