There is incomparable Glory for those He justified. v28-30; Rom 8:16-18

"The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, **if indeed we suffer with [Him]** so that we may also be glorified with [Him.] For I consider that **the sufferings of this present time** are **not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed** to us." - Rom 8:16-18

OUR INCOMPARABLE GLORY INCLUDES...

(1) ...a path of suffering for Christ's _____ that leads to glory. 2Th 1:10-12

- "...**those who honor Me** I will honor, and **those who despise Me** will be lightly esteemed. 1 Sam2:30
- "when **He comes to be glorified in His saints** on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed--for our testimony to you was believed. To this end also we pray for you always, that our God will count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power, so that **the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you**, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and [the] Lord Jesus Christ." - 2Th 1:10-12

"And He said to her, "What do you wish?" She said to Him, "Command that in Your kingdom these **two sons** of mine **may sit one on Your right and one on Your left**." But Jesus answered, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I am about to drink?" They said to Him, "We are able." He said to them, "My cup you shall drink; but to sit on My right and on [My] left, this is not Mine to give, but **it is for those for whom it has been prepared by My Father**." - Mat 20:21-23

"For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is [to be] revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work. If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire." - 1Co 3:11-15

"For what [is] our hope, or joy, or **crown of rejoicing**? **[Is it] not even you** in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming?" - 1Th 2:19 NKJV

...a crown of _____. 2Ti 4:8. **a award for longing for Messiah's return**

"in the future there is laid up for me **the crown of righteousness**, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to **all who have loved His appearing**." - 2Ti 4:8

...receiving the unfaded _____ of glory. 1Pe 5:1-4. **a award for faithful service**

"Therefore, I exhort the elders among you, as [your] fellow elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, and a partaker also of the glory that is to be revealed, **shepherd the flock of God** among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to [the will of] God; and not for sordid gain, but with eagerness; nor yet as lording it over those allotted to your charge, but proving to be examples to the flock. And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory." - 1Pe 5:1-4. **Faithfulness in service tending to God's people**

...a crown of _____. Rev 2:10. **a award for trials and persecution**

"Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you **the crown of life**." - Rev 2:10 **faithfulness for enduring trials & martyrdom**.

"He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, TO HIM **I WILL GIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE NATIONS**;" - Rev 2:26

...a throne to _____. Rev 3:21

"He who overcomes, **I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne**, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne." - Rev 3:21

...judging the _____. 1Co 6:2

"Or do you not know that **the saints will judge the world**? If the world is judged by you, are you not competent [to] [constitute] the smallest law courts?" - 1Co 6:2

"Do you not know that **we will judge angels**? How much more matters of this life?" - 1Co 6:3
