Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "God forbid [it,] Lord! This shall never happen to You." But He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me; for you are not setting your mind on God's interests, but man's."" - Mat 16:21-23 NASB95
