There is incomparable Glory for those He justified. v28-30; Rom 8:16-18

"The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, **if indeed we suffer with [Him]** so **that we may also be glorified with [Him].** For I consider that **the sufferings of this present time** are **not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed** to us." - Rom 8:16-18

- "when **He comes to be glorified in His saints** on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed--for our testimony to you was believed. To this end also we pray for you always, that our God will count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power, so that **the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you**, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and [the] Lord Jesus Christ." - 2Th 1:10-12
- "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of [the] archangel and with the trumpet of God, and **the dead in Christ will rise first**. Then **we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them** in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord." - 1Th 4:16-17 NASB95
- "in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For this **perishable must put on the imperishable**, and this **mortal must put on immortality**." - 1Co 15:52-53 NASB95

"In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials, so that **the proof of your faith**, [being] more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ;" - 1Pe 1:6-7

- ★ **dimensions** - 1500 miles - shaped like a cube.
- ★ **area** - 2,250,000 square miles. [USA 2,959,000]
- ★ **shape** - like the Holy of Holies [only 240,000 Xs as big].
- ★ **Wall** - 216 ft high.
- ★ **stones** - iridescent of every color
- ★ **street** - pure gold transparent like glass.
