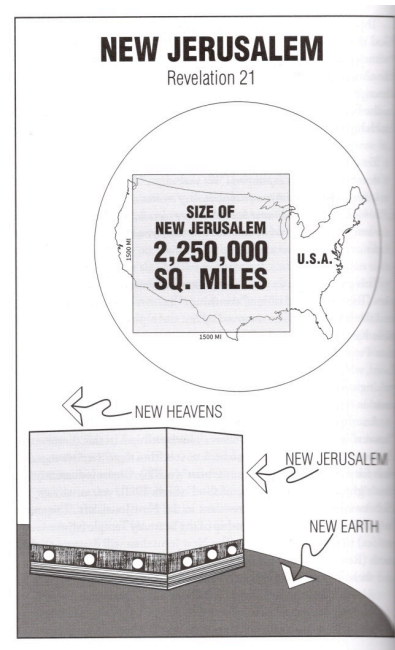
New Jerusalem
