- ...distress = anguish, narrow space
- ...persecution = put to flight or to pursue with repeated acts of enmity.

- ...famine = destitute, hungry, starved
- ...nakedness = destitute of clothing, indecent, exposure to elements
- ...perils = life threatening dangers. 2 Cor 11:26
