“For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who **suppress the truth in unrighteousness**,” - Rom 1:18 NASB95

“[There will be] **tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil**, of the Jew first and also of the Greek,” Rom 2:9 NASB95

3) What has God predestined for _____? v28

(1) ...deeds _____ in God. Jhn 3:20-21

"For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed. "But **he who practices the truth comes to the Light**, so that **his deeds may be manifested as having been wrought in God.**" - Jhn 3:20-21 NASB95

(2) ... _____ to Christ's image. Rom 8:29-30

"For those whom He foreknew, He also **predestined [to become] conformed to the image of His Son**, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren; and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified." - Rom 8:29-30 NASB95

(3) ... _____ as sons. Eph 1:3-5

"Blessed [be] the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly [places] in Christ, just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love **He predestined us to adoption as sons** through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will," - Eph 1:3-5 NASB95

(4) ...an _____ . Eph 1:11

"also **we have obtained an inheritance**, having been **predestined according to His purpose** who works all things **after the counsel of His will**," - Eph 1:11 NASB95

(5) ... _____ for you through Christ's suffering.. Act 4:27-28

"For truly in this city there were **gathered** together against Your holy servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel, **to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose predestined to occur.**" - Act 4:27-28 NASB95

"When the Gentiles heard this, they [began] rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord; and as many as had been **appointed [ordained]** to eternal life believed." - Act 13:48 NASB95
