"**do not be arrogant** toward the branches; but if you are arrogant, [remember that] it is not you who supports the root, but the root [supports] you." - Rom 11:18

- "You will say then, "Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in."" - Rom 11:19
- "Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith. **Do not be conceited**, but fear;" - Rom 11:20

"for if **God did not spare the natural branches**, He will not spare you, either." - Rom 11:21

2) God will not _____ Gentiles either. Mt 3:9; Rom 4:13

- "and do not suppose that you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham for our father'; for I say to you that **from these stones God is able to raise up children to Abraham.**" - Mat 3:9
- "For **the promise** to Abraham or **to his descendants** that he would be heir of the world **was** not through the Law, but **through the righteousness of faith.**" - Rom 4:13

6. Be _____ with [behold] God's kindness and His severity. v22

"**Behold** then **the kindness and severity** of God; to those who fell, severity, but to you, God's kindness, if you continue in His kindness; otherwise you also will be cut off." - Rom 11:22
