

## "Subjection to Civil Authority"

Romans 13:1-7 - Part 3

Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. [Rom 12:21 NASB95] Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. Respect what is right in the sight of all men. [Rom 12:17]

- 1. Be in <u>subjection</u> to governing authorities. v1
  - 1 Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. [Rom 13:1]

Governing authorities...

- 1) ...are delegated authority by God. Jn 19:10-11; Jhn 10:34-35
- 2) ...are <u>ordained</u> by God. Act 17:26
- 2. Resist governing authority and you resist God's authority. v2
  2 Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves. [Rom 13:2]
  - 1) You oppose God's ordained divine institution. Pro 20:22; 1Pe 2:13-15
  - 2) You receive condemnation. Heb 10:30; Jer 51:24
    - \* Why were they ordained?
      - **When were they ordained?** Genesis 9-10
- 3. Do good works and have praise from rulers. v3

3 For rulers are not a cause of fear for good behavior, but for evil. Do you want to have no fear of authority? Do what is good and you will have praise from the same; [Rom 13:3]

- 1) Rulers are to be feared by <u>evil doers</u>.
- 2) If you don't want to fear authority do good. 1Sa 26:23; Est 4:13-16
- 3) Those who do good receive praise from authority. Dan 6:4-5
  - **\*** When you must resist civil authorities? Act 5:41; Dan 3:16-18
  - \* Can you resist civil authorities and not resist God? 2Ki 11:1-18

4 for it is a minister of God to you for good. But if you do what is evil, be afraid; for it does not bear the sword for nothing; for it is a minister of God, an avenger who brings wrath on the one who practices evil. [Rom 13:4]

- 2) ...he bears a sword against evil. Gen 9:6
- 3) ...he acts to avenge evil on God's behalf.
