Introduction

1 Now accept the one who is weak in faith, [but] not for [the purpose of] passing judgment on his opinions. [Rom 14:1 NASB95]

***** How to live together in regard to sin and the lusts of the flesh. Clothe yourselves in Christ's ______. v14, Gal 3:27, Eph 4:24, Col 3:12

- 14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to [its] lusts. [Rom 13:14 NASB95]
- 27 For all of you who were baptized into Christ have *clothed yourselves with Christ*. [Gal 3:27 NASB95]
- 24 and *put on* the new self, which in [the likeness of] God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth. [Eph 4:24]
- So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on *a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience*; [Col 3:12]

- Summary of Romans 12 & 13

3 Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you **contend earnestly for the faith** which was once for all handed down to the saints. 4 For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand marked out for this condemnation, ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ. [Jde 1:3-4 NASB95]


