The just shall live by faith

4 By faith **Abel offered to God a better sacrifice** than Cain, through which **he obtained the testimony** that he was righteous, God testifying about his gifts, and through faith, **though he is dead, he still speaks**. 5 By faith Enoch was taken up so that he would not see death; AND HE WAS NOT FOUND BECAUSE GOD TOOK HIM UP; for **he obtained the witness** that before his being taken up he was pleasing to God. 6 And without faith it is impossible to please [Him,] for he who comes to God must believe that He is and [that] He is a rewarder of those who seek Him. [Heb 11:4-6 NASB95]

- 5 but for Cain and for his offering He had **no regard**. So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell. [Gen 4:5 NASB95]
- 17 Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree about which I commanded you, saying, 'You shall not eat from it'; Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you will eat of it All the days of your life. 18 "Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you; And you will eat the plants of the field; [Gen 3:17-18]

- 6 "Whoever sheds man's blood, By man his blood shall be shed, For in the image of God He made man. [Gen 9:6 NASB95]
- SANCTITY OF LIFE: We hold that all humankind is created in the image of God and is sacred from conception to natural death. (Genesis 1:26; Psalm 139:13-16; Jeremiah.1:5) Abortion on demand, infanticide, and euthanasia are morally and ethically reprehensible to God and should be opposed by God's people. We protest the killing of over 54,000,000 pre-born babies since the Roe vs. Wade decision in 1973.

 22 And according to the Law, [one may] almost [say,] all things are cleansed with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. [Heb 9:22 NASB95]
 - 11 'For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement. [Lev 17:11 NASB95]
 - 20 And in the same way [He took] the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood. [Luk 22:20 NASB95]

- 21 But now apart from the Law [the] righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, 22 even [the] righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; 25 whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. [This was] to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed; 26 for the demonstration, [I say,] of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. [Rom 3:21-26 NASB95]
