- 5 But to Hannah he gave a double portion, because he loved her, though the LORD had closed her womb. [1Sa 1:5 ESV]
- I3 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone. 14 But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust. 15 Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death. [Jas 1:13-15 NASB95]

- 7 So it went on year by year. As often as she went up to the house of the LORD, she [Peninnah] used to provoke her. Therefore Hannah wept and would not eat. ... 10 She was deeply distressed and prayed to the LORD and wept bitterly. [1Sa 1:7, 10 ESV]
- 18 The LORD is near to the brokenhearted And saves those who are crushed in spirit. [Psa 34:18 NASB95]
- I7 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; A broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise. [Psa 51:17 NASB95]
- 3 He heals the brokenhearted And binds up their wounds. [Psa 147:3 NASB95]

I1 To this end also we pray for you always, that our **God will** count you worthy of your calling, and **fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power**, [2Th 1:11 NASB95]

I0 She, greatly distressed, prayed to the LORD and wept bitterly. 11 She made a vow and said, "O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, but will give Your maidservant a son, then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life, and a razor shall never come on his head." [1Sa 1:10-11 NASB95]

I7 Then Eli answered and said, "Go in peace; and may the God of Israel grant your petition that you have asked of Him." 18 She said, "Let your maidservant find favor in your sight." So the woman went her way and ate, and *her face was no longer [sad.*] [1Sa 1:17-18 NASB95]

2) ...keep their _____ to God.

- 22 But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, "[I will not go up] until the child is weaned; then I will bring him, that he may appear before the LORD and stay there forever." 23 Elkanah her husband said to her, "Do what seems best to you. Remain until you have weaned him; only may the LORD confirm His word." So the woman remained and nursed her son until she weaned him. [1Sa 1:22-23 NASB95]
- I3 "Every vow and every binding oath to humble herself, her husband may confirm it or her husband may annul it. [Num 30:13 NASB95]
- 24 Now when she had weaned him, she took him up with her, with a three-year-old bull and one ephah of flour and a jug of wine, and brought him to the house of the LORD in Shiloh, *although the child was young*. [1Sa 1:24 NASB95]

3) ...find that you cannot out _____ God.

20 Then *Eli would bless Elkanah and his wife* and say, "May the LORD give you children from this woman in place of the one she dedicated to the LORD." And they went to their own home. 21 The LORD visited Hannah; and she conceived and gave birth to three sons and two daughters. And the boy Samuel grew before the LORD. [1Sa 2:20-21 NASB95]

- 29 'Why do you kick at My sacrifice and at My offering which I have commanded [in My] dwelling, and honor your sons above Me, by making yourselves fat with the choicest of every offering of My people Israel?' [1Sa 2:29 NASB95]
- 30 "Therefore the LORD God of Israel declares, 'I did indeed say that your house and the house of your father should walk before Me forever'; but now the LORD declares, 'Far be it from Me--for those who honor Me I will honor, and those who despise Me will be lightly esteemed. [1Sa 2:30]

1) ...acknowledge that God is our _____.

I Then Hannah prayed and said, "My heart exults in the LORD; My horn is exalted in the LORD, My mouth speaks boldly against my enemies, Because I *rejoice in Your salvation*. [1Sa 2:1 NASB95]

- 8 "He *raises the poor* from the dust, He *lifts the needy* from the ash heap To make them sit with nobles, And inherit a seat of honor; For the pillars of the earth are the LORD'S, And He set the world on them. [1Sa 2:8 NASB95]

- 9 "He keeps the feet of His godly ones, But the wicked ones are silenced in darkness; For not by might shall a man prevail. [1Sa 2:9 NASB95]
