- I What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we have looked at and touched with our hands, concerning the Word of Life-- 2 and the life was manifested, and we have seen and testify and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was manifested to us-- 3 what we have seen and heard we proclaim to you also, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father, and with His Son Jesus Christ. 4 These things we write, so that our joy may be made complete. - 1 The first account I composed, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and teach, 2 until the day when He was taken up [to heaven,] after He had by the Holy Spirit given orders to the apostles whom He had chosen. 3 To these He also presented Himself alive after His suffering, by many convincing proofs, appearing to them over [a period of] forty days and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God. [Act 1:1-3 NASB95]

- 9 And after He had said these things, He was lifted up while they were looking on, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. [Act 1:9 NASB95]

- 1 Six days later Jesus took with Him Peter and James and John his brother, and led them up on a high mountain by themselves. 2 And **He was transfigured before them**; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as white as light. 3 And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him. 4 Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, I will make three tabernacles here, one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah." 5 While he was still speaking, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and behold, a voice out of the cloud said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am wellpleased; listen to Him!" 6 When the disciples heard [this,] they fell face down to the ground and were terrified. 7 And Jesus came to [them] and touched them and said, "Get up, and do not be afraid." [Mat 17:1-7 NASB95]

 - ***** Christ's touch restored .
 - 2 And a leper came to Him and bowed down before Him, and said, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean." 3 Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, saving, "I am willing; be cleansed." And immediately his leprosy was cleansed. [Mat 8:2-3 NASB95]
 - 56 Wherever He entered villages, or cities, or countryside, they were laving **the sick** in the market places, and imploring Him that they might just touch the fringe of His cloak; and as many as touched it were being cured. [Mar 6:56 NASB95]

- 46 But Jesus said, "Someone did touch Me, for I was aware that **power had gone out of Me**." [Luk 8:46 NASB95]

 - § 6 "Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the first and I am the last, And there is no God besides Me. [Isa 44:6 NASB95]
 - 1 In the beginning **was** the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. ... 14 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth. [Jhn 1:1-3, 14 NASB95]
 - 58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am." 59 Therefore they picked up stones to throw at Him, but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple. [Jhn 8:58-59 NASB95]

- For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. [Jhn 3:16 NASB95]

- 18 ... and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore,...[Rev 1:18b]
 - 21 He made Him who knew no sin [to be] sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. [2Co 5:21 NASB95]
 - 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [Rom 5:8 NASB95]

- 18 ... and I have the keys of death and of Hades. [Rev 1:18c NASB95]
 - ² 14 Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives. [Heb 2:14-15 NASB95]
