

## "Kept from the Hour of Testing"

Revelation 3:10 September 28, 2025

#### **SCRIPTURE PASSAGE:**

"7 "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: 'The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens. 8 "'I know your works. Behold, I have set before you an open door, which no one is able to shut. I know that you have but little power, and yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name. 9 Behold, I will make those of the synagogue of Satan who say that they are Jews and are not, but lie--behold, I will make them come and bow down before your feet, and they will learn that I have loved you. 10 Because you have kept my word about patient endurance, I will keep you from the hour of trial that is coming on the whole world, to try those who dwell on the earth. 11 I am coming soon. Hold fast what you have, so that no one may seize your crown. 12 The one who conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God. Never shall he go out of it, and I will write on him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down from my God out of heaven, and my own new name. 13 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.'" [Rev 3:7-13 ESV]

### INTRODUCTION

Jesus knows your works that you...

- 1) ...have kept His word.
- 2) ...have not denied His name.
- 3) ...have kept my word about patient endurance. v10

In Prophecy a near prophetic event is to be a type for a distant antitype - a prophetic fulfillment of God's plan.

- 1) Eliakim was a type of the ascended Christ
- 2) The Passover Lamb was a type of the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.
- 3) Psalm 23 the Lord is my shepherd was a type of Christ the good shepherd.

The three behold phrases tell of the future benefits of the believer's service.

- 1) A near future open door of ministry opportunity for the Philadelphians.
- 2) A more distant prophetic fulfillment of deliverance from the tribulation.
- 3) A far distant prophetic fulfillment of life in the New Heavens and New Earth.
- 1. Christs will keep the \_\_\_\_\_\_ faithful church from the hour of trial.

  "10 'Because you have kept the word of My perseverance, I also will keep you from the hour of testing, that [hour] which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth." [Rev 3:10 NASB95]

## **GLORIOUS APPEARING**

- 1. Christ comes for His own (John 14:3;IThess. 14:17;2Thess.2:1).
- 2. He comes in the air (1 Thess. 4:17)
- 3. He claims His bride
- 4. Removal of believers (1 Thess 4:17).
- 5. Only His own see Him (1 Thess. 4:13-18)
- 6. Tribulation begins.
- 7. Saved are delivered from wrath (1 Thess. 1:10; 5-9)
- 8. No signs precede Rapture (1 Thess. 5:1-3).
- 9. Focus: Lord and Church (1 Thess. 4:13-18).
- 10. World is deceived. (2 Thess. 2:3-12)

- 1. Christ comes with His own (1 Thess. 3:13; Jude 14; Rev. 19:14).
- 2. He comes to the earth Zech. 14:4; Acts1:11).
- 3. He comes with His bride (Rev. 19:6-14).
